California State University Fullerton Jazz Orchestra, directed by <u>Bill Cunliffe</u>, consistently receives high scores and acclaim at major west coast jazz festivals. They have been featured on a live radio broadcast across North America as part of the Playboy Jazz Festival, and have previously won the Pacific Coast Collegiate Jazz Festival competing against groups from 50 colleges and universities in seven western states. Jazz combos receive high marks as well, with CSUF's top combo winning the 2018 Reno College Jazz Festival. Fullerton Jazz Orchestra has performed, by invitation, at many leading Southern California festivals and events. They have produced five recordings including their latest, "Sabor!" which features vocalist Freda Payne.

Option Two: \$20.00 per student

To enrol only in the High Schools Jazz Competition.

NOTE: It must be said that this is the basic option to attend the festival jazz competition. We would encourage all students to use option one as it is not just to play in the jazz competition but also to be part of the festival and learn by meeting and listening to other musicians and attending the educational workshops.

Entry Criteria - 2024

There are two categories:

IMPORTANT: The following two categories must present a program of not more than 20 minutes performance and 10 minutes master-classes total of 30 minutes, including setup and pack down time. This time constraint will be strictly adhered to.

(1) High Schools Big Band/Stage Band Competition

Musicians to be attending a High School or College with each band having a minimum of 10 musicians and a maximum of 22 (not including the band director). Each band is to play four pieces of different styles from this list; swing, blues, Latin, rock, ballad

(2) High School Combo Section

Musicians to be attending a High School or College with each group having a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 9 people

Vocalists can be used in any section and are included in the overall numbers required by each performing group.

Band Awards

There are 4 categories of best band awards:

- High School Big Band/Stage Band
- High School Combo
- Best Manawatu School Big Band/Stage Band
- First Time appearance at the festival by a High School Combo or Big Band

Individual Awards

Categories of individual awards:

- High School students will compete for trophy awards for the following instruments: Trumpet, Saxophone, Trombone, Guitar, Bass, Drums, Vocal, Keyboard/Piano, Flute/Clarinet
- Most Outstanding Musician in the Competition.
